What are the entry requirements?

This qualification is open access and no prior qualifications are required. However, a reasonable level of literacy and numeracy will be expected.

There are two mandatory units and students are then required to complete two option units from a choice of six topics.

Option units:

- Introduction to Freight Transport Services
- Introduction to Passenger Transport Services
- Introduction to Warehousing and Inventory
- Introduction to Purchasing

- Introduction to Planning and Operating Passenger Transport

How long does the course take?

For candidates who are taking the full qualification, the guided learning for this course is 160 hours, but this can vary.
